

2022 Stage One (Year One and Year Two) Homework

Dear Parent/Carer,

The students in Year One and Year Two will receive a weekly homework sheet to be completed each night. The teachers will set homework that should take approximately 20 minutes to complete. Students should not spend excessive amounts of time completing homework. Should this be the case, please contact the class teacher as soon as possible.

We encourage parents/carers to supervise their child in completing homework. However, students should attempt all homework tasks themselves.

Homework will consist of activities drawn from most curriculum areas, but in particular, English and Mathematics. Teachers will explain all of the activities to the students. It will be presented to students in stencil form and it is to be pasted in the requested homework book. Students will also need to check their Google Classroom as they will receive one online task to complete each week.

Parents are requested to buy two A4 96 page lined books. The homework books should be neatly covered, with the child's name and class clearly marked. Teachers understand that there are occasions when homework cannot be completed on a given afternoon and encourage students to work out a timetable that best suits them and their family. The homework book and folder are to be returned to school on Friday and the teacher will mark it, change the reader and return them to the student on Monday. Homework will be completed at school for the first couple of weeks.

Homework is to be completed neatly in **lead pencil**. Pictures and drawings are to be coloured using pencils or twist up crayons. Please do not allow your child to use textas.

It would be appreciated if parents could supervise their child while doing homework or allocate a quiet area where your child can concentrate. This will provide a quality learning environment for your child while completing their homework. The teacher will keep a record of homework completed.

Check the whole homework sheet on Monday night, and if unsure of any activities, check with your child's teacher the following day. Should you have any concerns about your child's homework, please contact the class teacher immediately.

Please follow the format that the children have learnt when completing their spelling words. LSCWC-L stands for look at the word, S stands for say the word out loud, C stands for cover up the word, W stands for write the word and C stands for check the spelling of the word. If your child spells a word incorrectly, encourage them to write it again next to their mistake. Please note that spelling lists should be written each night to reinforce learning and aid progress.


