Special Swimming Scheme 2013 - Our Special Swimming Scheme takes place in **Term 3 (Weeks 5 & 6)**, from **Monday 12 August to Friday 23 August 2013**. It is open to students in Years 2 - 6. It will be held at Tides Aquatic in Smithfield. It is a privately owned pool, not open to the general public. The scheme will be held for ten days, the total cost being **\$60.00 (\$6.00 per day for a 45 minute lesson with fully qualified swimming instructors)**.

The first 60 students from each session will be allowed to attend - Group 1 - Years 5 & 6, Group 2 - Year 2 and Group 3 - Years 3 & 4.
